Poly Studio G62 is a modular room video conferencing system capable of running Poly VideoOS and native third-party applications. At launch, Microsoft Teams Rooms and Poly Video mode are supported.

Note Poly Studio G62 ships with Poly VideoOS 4.1.5. Update your system to Poly VideoOS 4.2.0, at minimum, as part of setting up your system.



You can mount your Poly Studio G62 using the supplied magnetic feet or the optional magnetic plate. For information on mounting your Poly Studio G62 system, review the *Poly Studio G62 Quick Start Guide*.

Poly Studio G62 product overview

The Poly Studio G62 system is an Android-based video conferencing system with HDMI, IP LLN, and USB connections to support custom conference rooms.

Poly Studio G62 is designed with simplified mounting and PoE+ power, so you can place it behind a display, under a table, or in an AV rack. The Poly Studio G62 system supports Poly audio and video products over IP LLN as well as Poly and third-party products over USB.

The Poly Studio G62 system brings the following functionality to your conferencing space:

- Audio innovations such as NoiseBlock AI
- Sound Reflection Reduction
- DirectorAl camera framing and tracking
- Configurable second network port for accessories
- Dual monitor 4K video
- Flexible installation with cable management
- USB-C DP Alt Mode port for content and device mode
- Wireless content sharing using Airplay or Miracast



1	3.5 mm output	Connects speakers to the system.	
2	3.5 mm input	Connects microphones to the system.	
3	USB Type-A ports (3.0)	Connects USB cameras or USB audio DSPs.	
4	HDMI input	 Provides the following options: Connects an HDMI content source or HDMI camera. Use the system monitor when connected to a computer HDMI port. Provides content sharing capabilities. 	
5	USB Type-C port	 Provides the following options: Use the system camera, speaker, and microphone from a connected laptop. Use the system camera, speaker, microphone, 	

Item	Port	Description
		and monitor using a DP Alt-mode connection. Requires a supported DP Alt-mode cable and a computer with a USB Type-C port that supports DP Alt-mode.
6	Pinhole reset	Factory resets the system.
7	HDMI 2	Connects a secondary monitor.
8	HDMI 1	Connects a primary monitor.
9	LLN port	Connects IP peripherals such as a Poly IP microphone or Poly IP camera. This port doesn't provide power. A PoE switch or PoE injector is required to power IP peripherals connected to the LLN port.
10	PoE+ power input	Powers the Poly Studio G62 system using a class 4 PoE+ injector or PoE+ switch. Provides access to the corporate network.
11	Security lock	Physically secures the system.

Connect a supported Alt DP cable to a Alt DP capable USB-C port on your computer to use the system speakers, microphones, camera, and monitors from your system.

Set up your system

Before powering on your Poly Studio G62 system for the first time, connect a monitor, camera, microphone, and audio output to the system.

Note Before powering on your Poly Studio G62 system, connect all components. If you need to add or remove a USB peripheral, power off the system.

The following setup uses Poly IP microphones and a 3.5 mm sound bar speaker for audio. Alternatively, you can connect a supported USB audio DSP to your system.

Procedure

1 Mount the Poly Studio G62 using the magnetic feet or mounting plate.

For more information on mounting your Poly Studio G62, see the *Poly Studio G62 Quick Start Guide*.

- 2 Connect an HDMI cable from the HDMI 1 port on a monitor to the Poly Studio G62 HDMI 1 port.
- **3 Optional:** To view participants and content simultaneously, connect a second monitor to the Poly Studio G62 HDMI 2 port.
- 4 Connect a microphone, such as a Poly IP table microphone to a PoE injector or supported Netgear A/V Line M4250 GSM4210PD.Ethernet switch.

Connect the Ethernet switch or PoE injector to the LLN port on the Poly Studio G62.

5 Connect a speaker, such as a JBL Pro SoundBar PSB-1, to the 3.5 mm audio output port on the Poly Studio G62 system.

On the JBL Soundbar, set the Source Volume to Variable and the Volume to Low.

6 To power on the Poly Studio G62, connect the system to a PoE+ class 4 power injector or Ethernet switch.

Connect the power injector or Ethernet switch to your network.

7 Connect a Poly TC10 or Poly TC8 touch controller to a PoE Ethernet port on the same subnet as your Poly Studio G62.

Follow the out-of-box instructions on the Poly TC10 or Poly TC8.

8 If necessary, factory reset your Poly TC10 or Poly TC8 to initiate the out-of-box setup.

Calling	EN-250298	In Teams Rooms mode, you can't leave call while a whiteboarding session is in progress.	End the whiteboarding session before leaving the call.
Calling	EN-248844	In Teams Rooms mode, the dialpad is different out of a call than when in a call.	No workaround.
Camera	EN-252763	In Teams Rooms mode, camera presets don't work.	No workaround
Camera	EN-251114	In Zoom Rooms, after hog plugging a camera, some PTZ buttons don't work.	Turn the system off before plugging in a USB camera. Hot plugging cameras isn't supported.
Camera	EN-248805	EagleEye IV produces low quality video in Poly Video mode.	No workaround.
Camera	EN-248330	In Teams Rooms mode, Poly TC10 shows the incorrect meeting camera status.	No workaround.
